Minute for Mission: Our gifts for M&S support children harmed by civil war. Marie was 11 years old when she was raped and became pregnant – a story of many girls in the Democratic Republic of Congo. The country's citizens have been traumatized by a long-standing and brutal conflict. 5.4 million died, millions have been uprooted & displaced. Many social services are not provided by the state, so hospitals and schools are run by churches like M&S partner Eglise du Christ au Congo, Department of Women, Children & Family. This partner has long supported unaccompanied children, many of whom are survivors of sexual violence. Some 150 children are gathered at PRENAO Light School where they continue their education and get help dealing with the trauma they have experienced. Young girls, who are also mothers, are supported. They learn a trade or skill that enables them to earn a living and make a life for themselves and their children. They also receive psychological support and trauma counselling. Marie has twin boys, now residing at PRENAO while she continues her studies at university. We sing thanksgiving for our global partners who are transforming lives.
