- D. Group is dedicated to promoting the development of individual, lifelong, and community-based supports and services starting from childhood.
- E. Group can trace its beginning to mid 1600s - Time of the Pilgrims.
- F. Group works with children and parents/caregivers.
- G. Faith group started in 2006.
- H. Group provides a Pastoral Ministry to the Deaf.
- I. Members use the sense of sight to interpret surroundings and a special language to communicate.
- J. Group has been influential in enabling participation of its members in modified athletic activities.
- K. Group includes representatives from the Jewish, Christian, Sikh, Muslim and Hindu religious communities.
- L. Group establishes home(s) for individuals with intellectual disabilities and their live-in assistants.
- M. Members celebrate holidays such as Rosh Hashana, Yom Kippur, and Sukkoth.
- N. United and Anglican churches work together to provide a joint ministry to affected persons.
- O. Ecumenical committee, including the United Church, concerned with ending poverty.
- P. Core members are adults with intellectual disabilities.
